We are writing to inform you that effective May 31, 2024, or anytime during the 14-day period thereafter, Concordia University, Inc., also known as Concordia University of Wisconsin and Ann Arbor (the "University") will begin terminating employees as a result of the University's decision to reduce personnel at both campuses to improve the University's financial position, resulting in a reduction-in-force at the University's Wisconsin campus in Mequon. The terminations will impact the University's operations located at the University's Mequon Campus, 12800 N Lake Shore Drive, Mequon, WI 53097, and the terminations will be permanent ("Mequon Campus").

The University anticipates that the terminations will begin on May 31, 2024, or anytime during the 14-day period thereafter. A total of **24** employees will be terminated as a result of reduction-in-force at the Mequon Campus. The University's employees are not represented by a union and do not have any bumping rights. The University has provided as much advance notice as is practicable of the terminations.
