## QUARTERLY REVIEW

*January 1—March 31, 2022-2024*

### Part I Crime

In 2024 compared to 2023:

- Part I crimes have decreased 10% (5,384) from (5,968)
- Homicides decreased 39% (23) from (38)
- Robberies decreased 14% (358) from (416)
- Property crime decreased 11% (3,445) from (3,863)

### Crash Data

In 2024 compared to 2023:

- Crashes remained the same at 3,415 in 2024 compared to 3,423 in 2023
- Hit and run crashes decreased 1% (1,258) from (1,269)
- Fatalities decreased 44% (9) from (16)

### Clearance Rates

In 2024, the homicide clearance rate is 83%.

**Data Methods:** Part I crime data was obtained from the DCS Fact table and counts distinct incidents (with the exception of rape, aggravated assault and human trafficking which count victims) for the time period of January 1—March 31, 2022-2024. Homicide and non-fatal shooting data was obtained from the respective OMAP Homicide and Non-Fatal Shooting databases and counts victims for the same time period above. Carjacking data was obtained from the OMAP Carjacking database and counts distinct incidents for the same time period above. Crash data was obtained from TraCS 10 and counts distinct crashes for the same time period above. Fatal crash data was obtained from OMAP Fatal Crash database and counts victims for the same time period above. UCR Homicide clearances were obtained from the Homicide Division and reflects homicides cleared by arrest or exceptional means and includes clearances of prior year homicides.
