Elijah Vue has not been found.

Today marks six months since Elijah Vue was reported missing. Elijah is always on our minds within our agency and we continue to be hopeful that we will locate him. We are confident that our investigation will ultimately reveal the truth of Elijah's disappearance.

We continue to follow up on tips and leads with the help of our local, state and federal law enforcement partners. In the last several months we have conducted further searches utilizing private search and rescue groups on land, water and in the air. We continue to analyze extensive amounts of data from these searches, utilizing specialized equipment and technology such as software designed to detect anomalies in the earth. In the coming weeks we plan to continue our search efforts using additional aerial searches with this technology.

Recently rumors surfaced online and on social media platforms stating Elijah has been found. This is not true. The spreading of false and misleading information is disrespectful to the family of Elijah and detracts from our efforts in locating him. We have also been made aware of fake "Go Fund Me" or similar pages that have been set up and we advise the public to beware and report these scams. We are also aware of some individuals who appear close to the case and have proven ulterior motives by spreading false information. We would like to remind everyone that we remain the sole source of factual information in this investigation and will release more information and updates when they are available to share.

We feel its important for the public to know that while they might have seen us in the last several months resuming standard operations within our community such as calls for service, community events and the like, the search for Elijah and the investigation still continues and remains our priority. Our investigative team, including members of our agency, led by the Wisconsin Department of Justice Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) is actively working on this investigation as are other entities outside our department.

This is still an active investigation and we are working hard to find answers. We will continue to share any information as we can. Thank you for your continued support.
