Political Rally May Cause Afternoon Transportation Disruptions

MADISON, Wis. (Oct. 22, 2024)—The Madison Metropolitan School District (MMSD) is anticipating potential disruptions to Tuesday afternoon transportation service due to a political rally being held at the Alliant Energy Center.

The most impacted areas are expected to be downtown and the Beltline. Yellow bus, special education and Metro Transit routes may all experience delays.
