Notice of Pertussis Cases in the Port Washington-Saukville School District

PORT WASHINGTON, WI — Port Washington-Saukville School District working with Washington Ozaukee Health Department to address increase in pertussis cases.

Wisconsin is experiencing a significant increase in cases of pertussis (also known as whooping cough) state-wide and locally. The Port Washington-Saukville School District is working closely with the local health department regarding recent cases of pertussis in the district. Over the past few weeks, PWSSD families have been notified about these cases and potential exposures. As the safety and well-being of our students remain our highest priority, we are in ongoing discussions with the Washington Ozaukee County Health Department about mitigation measures, including cleaning procedures and other recommendations, to ensure a safe school environment. We will continue to provide PWSSD families with updates based on the guidance we receive from the health department.
