## THE BELOW NAMED COMPLAINANT BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

## Count 1: INVASION OF PRIVACY - SURVEILLANCE DEVICE (VICTIM UNDER AGE 18)

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, October 7, 2024, at 1818 West National Avenue, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did knowingly install a surveillance device in a private place, or used a surveillance device to observe in a private place, with the intent to observe any nude or partially nude person without the consent of the person observed, and the victim of the violation had not, at the time of the violation, attained the age of 18 years, contrary to sec. 942.08(2)(a) and (4), 939.50(3)(i) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class I Felony, the defendant may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10.000), or imprisoned not more than three (3) years and six (6) months, or both.

## **Probable Cause:**

Complainant is a City of Milwaukee law enforcement officer. They base this complaint on information and belief and on a review of official police reports prepared by fellow City of Milwaukee police officers. These are of the kind Complainant has used in the past and found to be truthful and reliable and which Complainant knows were prepared in the ordinary and regular course of police business.

On February 19, 2025, Milwaukee Police Officers Booth and Sprewer were dispatched to an invasion of privacy complaint at Cristo Rey Jesuit High School on 1818 West National Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. They spoke to Vice President of Operations staff member MTP and Human Resource Administrator GB the former Security Coordinator at the school.

MTP explained that the defendant was terminated and ordered to turn over his school laptop and iPhone. However, the defendant refused to give back the items. The defendant demanded that he be allowed to remove personal items from the electronics before turning them over. Eventually, the defendant acquiesced in turning over the electronics.

The defendant told staff that he needed to retrieve personal property from a staff locker room before leaving. GB escorted the defendant into the locker room. The defendant told GB "you wouldn't want people to think the wrong thing of us in here together." As a result, GB waited by the doorway. GB noticed that the defendant was taking an unusual amount of time to retrieve his personal items.

The defendant exited the locker room with two full backpacks. The defendant showed GB a pair of shoes in one backpack, but refused to open the other one. Afterwards, GB and MTP conducted an inventory of property items inside the defendant's office. They recovered a small black camera with an SD card inside. Staff checked the SD card which contained hundreds of videos, many of which were taken inside the high school girls locker room.

Detective Miner reviewed the SD card which contained hundreds of videos with date/time stamps. The videos were recorded between May 21, 2024, and February 1, 2025. Most of the videos were taken at the Cristo Ray high school. Detective Miner determined the camera was motion activated.

Detective Miner reviewed 379 videos with time stamps from October 7 – 8, 2024. One video shows the defendant installing a camera inside the high school girl's locker room. The camera is discreetly placed inside a closed locker with grates. The video shows the defendant adjust the camera in a position towards the bathroom sinks. Afterwards, the defendant closes the locker and locks it with a padlock. Over the course of both days, the defendant captures hundreds of 10 second videos of high school girls using the locker room. There are a few videos of female students in their underwear and bra. One high school girl is seen partially nude while taking off her bra. However, the video only captures her backside.

Detective Miner conducted a sweep of the school, including bathrooms used by students. He did not locate any other secret cameras. MTP stated that the locker room is only used by female students in grades nine through twelve. MTP stated the majority of students are under the age of 18.Cristo Rey Jesuit High School did not give the defendant permission to install secret cameras inside the girls locker room.
