Catalytic Converter Thefts Disrupt School Bus Transportation

1505 Arcadian Ave, First Student Inc

WAUKESHA, Wis. – The City of Waukesha Police Department is currently investigating the theft of approximately 20 catalytic converters from a local school bus company, which occurred overnight. The theft was discovered early this morning, just prior to the start of scheduled student transportation services.

As a result, several school bus routes are expected to be delayed or canceled today. School officials and the bus company are actively working to notify affected families and coordinate alternative transportation plans where possible.

This type of crime not only impacts property but directly affects the daily lives of students and families. We are dedicating a significant amount of investigative resources to identify those responsible and bring them to justice.

The catalytic converters were stolen from parked buses located at 1505 Arcadian Ave, First Student Inc. Investigators are reviewing surveillance footage and seeking any witnesses or individuals with information related to this crime.
