## YEAR END REVIEW

### January 1—December 31, 2023-2025

#### Part I Crime

2025 Compared to 2024:

- Part I crimes have decreased 17% (21,216) from (25,708).
- Non-Fatal Shootings decreased 19% (515) from (639).
- Carjackings decreased 49% (264) from (513).
- Property crimes decreased 15% (13,975) from (16,411).
- Homicides increased 8% (142) from (132).

#### Crash Data

- Crashes were consistent (14,299) from (14,324).
- Hit and run crashes were consistent (5,421) from (5,410).
- Fatal crashes decreased 17% (55) from (66).

#### Clearance Rate

- In 2025, the homicide clearance rate was 87%.

**Data Methods:** Part I crime data was obtained from the DCS Fact table and counts incidents (with the exception of rape, aggravated assault, and human trafficking which count victims) for the time period of January 1 - December 31, 2023-2025. Homicide and non-fatal shooting data was obtained from the OMAP Homicide and Non-Fatal Shooting databases and counts victims for the same time period above. Carjacking data was obtained from the OMAP Carjacking database and counts distinct incidents for the same time period above. Crash data was obtained from TraCS 10 and counts distinct crashes for the same time period above. Fatal crash data was obtained from the OMAP Fatal Crash database and counts victims for the same time period above. UCR Homicide clearances were obtained from the Homicide Division and reflects homicides cleared by arrest or exceptional means and include prior year clearances.
