West Milwaukee homicide.

On Sunday, July 19th, 2026 at approximately 3:37am, the West Milwaukee Police Department responded to the 1200 block of S. 52nd street for a domestic violence incident.

Upon arrival, police discovered two victims with multiple stab wounds. A 25 year old West Milwaukee woman sustained non-life threatening injuries, she was treated at an area hospital and released. A 28 year old Milwaukee man sustained fatal injuries, he was transported to the Milwaukee County Medical Examiners Office. Police are looking for a known suspect a 25 year old Milwaukee man who fled the scene prior to the arrival of police. An arrest warrant has been issued. Police believe that was a targeted and isolated incident. WMPD will be forwarding charges to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office. This is an ongoing investigation, any developments will be updated on WMPD case 26-006512.

Update

West Milwaukee Police has arrested the suspect in this case, he will be charged with first degree intentional homicide and first degree reckless injury. There are no other offenders at large. The suspect will be awaiting charges at the Criminal Justice Facility.



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
