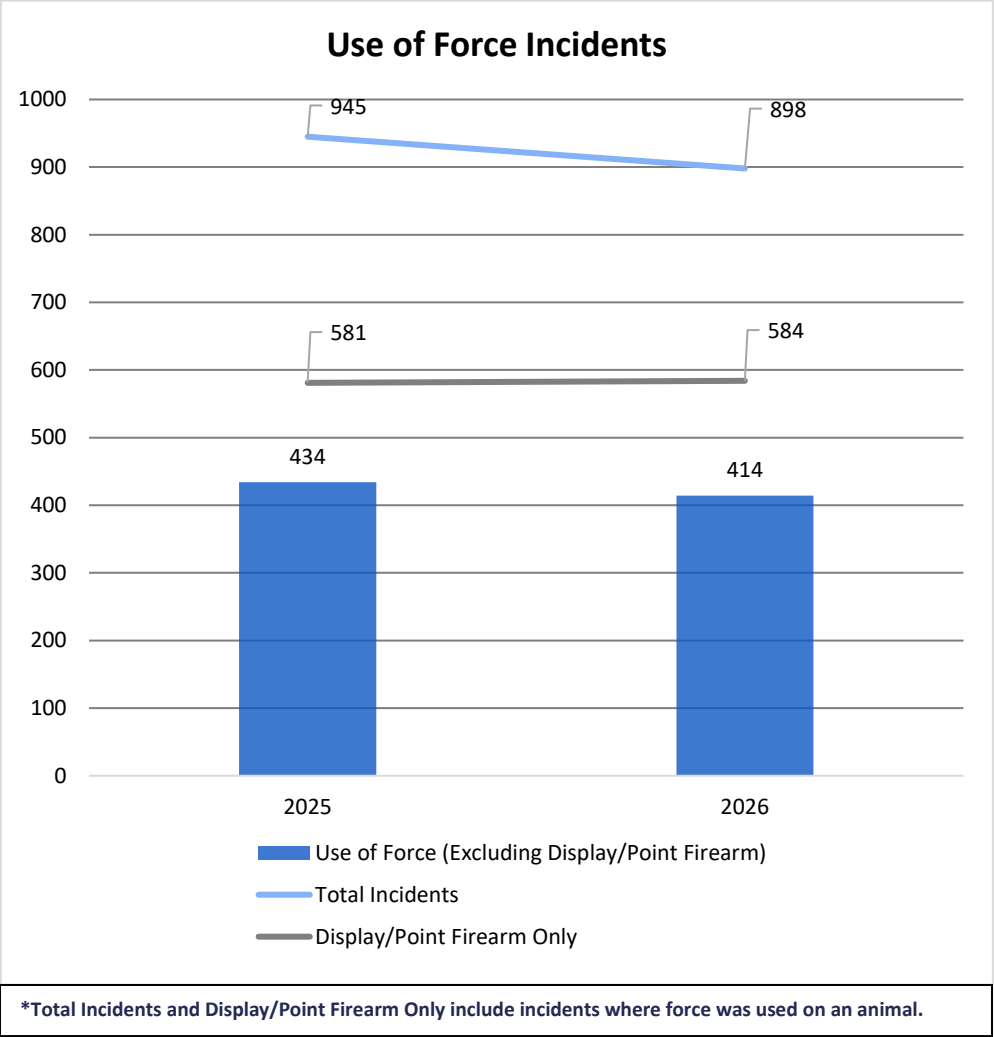

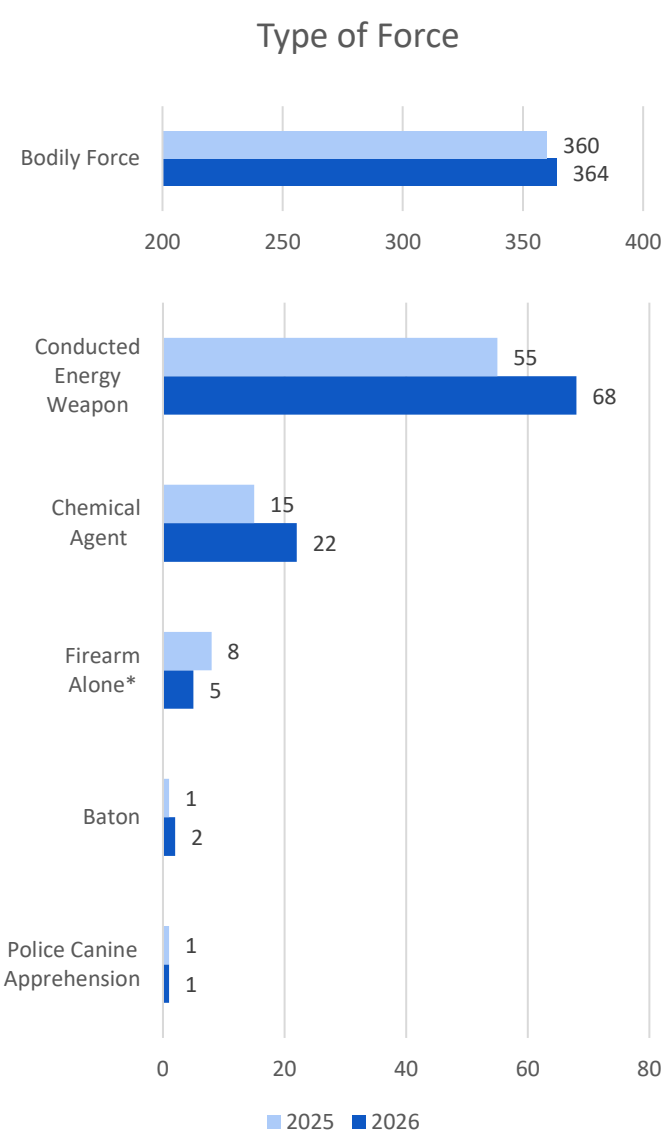

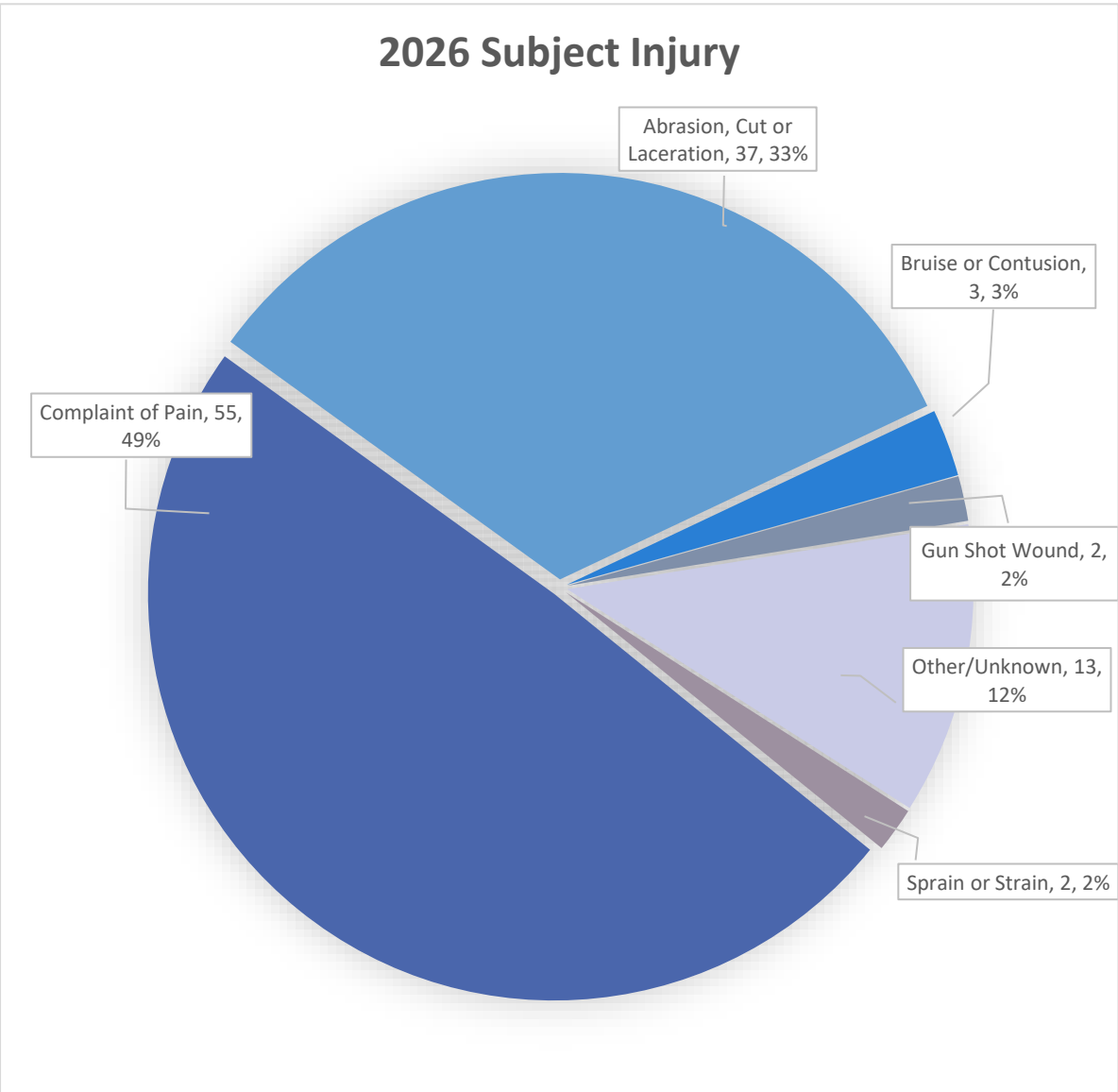
Data was obtained from the Milwaukee Police Department Internal Affairs Division and counts distinct incidents for the time period of January 1 – June 30, 2025/2026, excluding force used on animals. Subject data reflects distinct subjects for the same time period.



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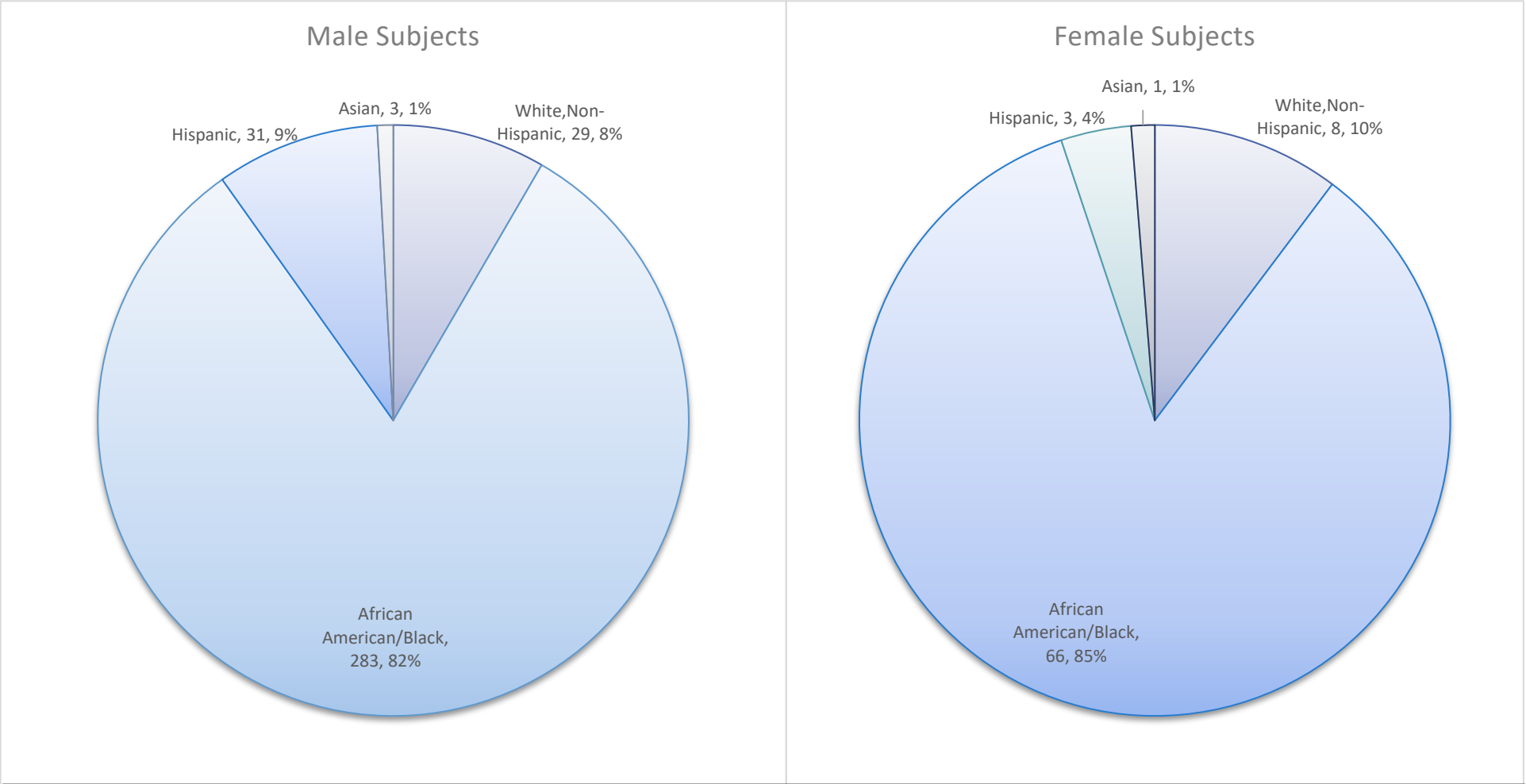


*Firearm Alone includes intentional and unintentional discharge. Note there is a margin of error with intentional/unintentional incidents.



In 2026, 93% (104) of injured subjects sustained minor injuries.

Data was obtained from the Milwaukee Police Department Internal Affairs Division and counts distinct incidents for the time period of January 1 – June 30, 2025/2026, excluding force used on animals. Subject data reflects distinct subjects for the same time period.



*Note the above charts do not include subjects with an unknown sex.

From January 1 – June 30, 2026, the median age of both male and female subjects was 26 years old.
